GENERAL EVENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. REGISTRATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The BLACKBERRY® SECURITY SUMMIT 2020 (the "Event") is a virtual conference that will be hosted by BLACKBERRY on October 5-7, 2020. By registering for the Event, you (the "Registrant", "you") agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.

2. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Program Events and Presentations:

(A) BLACKBERRY reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to make changes to the Event program. Every effort will be made to keep presentations and speakers as represented. However, unforeseen circumstances may result in the substitution of presentation topic(s) or speaker(s).

(B) In the event that the Event has to be cancelled or changed due to events beyond BLACKBERRY's control, BLACKBERRY will not be held liable to Registrants for any damages, losses or costs incurred. BLACKBERRY is not liable for changes in program date, content or speakers.

3. PARTICIPATION

(A) BLACKBERRY reserves the right to restrict participation in the Event and all associated ancillary events at its sole discretion.

(B) Registrants must have reached the age of majority in their respective state, province or territory of residence in order to register for the Event.

(C) For Registrants who are public officials or employees of a government department, ministry, agency or government-owned enterprise, you agree that your participation in the Event is for legitimate business purposes related to the activities of your employer or the government department, ministry, agency or government-owned enterprise that you represent, and that you have not been requested by any person and have not offered to provide any business advantage or other benefit for or on behalf of BLACKBERRY as a condition of your participation in the Event. 5. RELEASE FROM LIABILITY

(A) By attending the Event, you agree to release and hold BLACKBERRY, its subsidiaries, affiliates, agents and representatives and each of their officers, directors, agents, representatives and employees (each a "Released Party" and collectively, "Released Parties"), harmless from any and all liability, losses or damages whatsoever for any injuries, losses or damages of any kind, except bodily injury or death to the extent caused by a Released Party, arising from participation in or in connection with the Event.

(B) By agreeing to these Terms and Conditions, you release and discharge BLACKBERRY and its service providers and their respective parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, officers, directors, agents, representatives, and employees from any and all liability, losses or damages resulting from: (i) late, lost, delayed, stolen, misdirected, incomplete, unreadable, inaccurate, garbled or unintelligible communications or affidavits, regardless of the method of transmission; (ii) telephone system, telephone or computer hardware, software or other technical or computer malfunctions, lost connections, disconnections, delays or transmission errors; (iii) data corruption, theft, destruction, unauthorized access to or alteration of registration data; and (iv) any printing, typographical, administrative or technological errors in any materials associated with the Event; or (v) any liability for damage to any computer system resulting from participating in, or accessing or downloading information in connection with this Event.

6. CONSENT TO USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

(A) By completing and submitting the information requested on the Event Registration form to BLACKBERRY and/or its affiliated companies, you consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of the information by BLACKBERRY or its service providers and partners on BLACKBERRY's behalf: (i) to administer registration, participation and access to the event(s); (ii) to permit sponsors to contact you in advance of and following the Event; (iii) to contact you after the event(s) for event evaluation purposes and for subsequent event notifications and registrations; (iv) for BLACKBERRY's internal use, including without limitation, to: (a) understand and meet your needs and preferences, (b) develop new and enhance existing services and product offerings, (c) manage and develop BLACKBERRY's business and operations, and (d) to provide you with relevant information on BLACKBERRY and/or its products and/or services; and (iv) for the purposes set out in BLACKBERRY's Privacy Policy which can be found at <https://us.blackberry.com/legal/privacy-policy>. Except as set out herein, BLACKBERRY will not disclose your personal information to third parties for marketing or other secondary purposes, although BLACKBERRY may disclose aggregated, non-identifying data relating to the event for marketing or other purposes.

(B) By visiting a sponsor's virtual booth or attending a sponsored session during the Event, you consent to opt in and receive communications from that sponsor company. You will be subject to their communications and privacy policies and must opt out with them directly.

7. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

(A) All information and materials presented or distributed at or in connection with the Event are the intellectual property owned by BLACKBERRY, or the sponsor(s) or speaker(s) presenting at the Event. You may not use or reproduce or allow anyone to use or reproduce any trademarks or other trade names appearing at the Event, in any Event content or in any materials distributed at or in connection with the Event for any reason without the prior written permission of BLACKBERRY or its respective owner.

(B) Audio and video recording, photographs, and screenshots of the Event are strictly prohibited unless you have obtained express written consent from BLACKBERRY. By attending the Event, you agree not to

record, broadcast and/or distribute any audio or video recording, photographs, or screenshots of any presentation or session of the Event without the express written permission from BLACKBERRY.

8. GENERAL

(A) BLACKBERRY may film, photograph or audio record portions of the Event, including lectures and presentations. These recordings may be archived and used for educational and commercial purposes. By attending, Registrant consents to BLACKBERRY's global and perpetual use of his or her name, photograph, image, likeness, recorded voice and statements ("Information") in whole or in part, in all media and/or distribution formats, now known and hereafter developed for any lawful purpose, including but not limited to marketing, advertising, publicity, educational, sales, trade, and promotional purposes, with no right of approval and no right to compensation. Registrant releases and discharges BLACKBERRY from and against any and all claims, damages, costs and/or other liability arising from or relating to use of the Information. BLACKBERRY shall be the exclusive owner of any and all rights, title and interest, including, without limitation, copyright, electronic and distribution rights, in and to any materials containing the Information created by or on behalf of BLACKBERRY, in any form.

(B) BLACKBERRY reserves the right in its sole discretion to amend these Terms & Conditions to remedy administrative, including without limitation, typographical errors.

(C) This Agreement shall be governed by and construed under the laws of the State of New York and the laws of the United States of America applicable therein. Each Party hereto irrevocably waives any objection on the grounds of venue, forum non-conveniens or any similar grounds and irrevocably consents to service of process by mail or in any other manner permitted by applicable law and consents to the jurisdiction of the courts located in the State of New York.
