- 3. **Be lawful.** Don't violate any applicable laws or regulations, or post or transmit spyware, malware, viruses, or anything that may disrupt service or harm others;
- 4. **Be truthful**. Don't impersonate any person or entity, or falsely state or otherwise misrepresent your affiliation with a person or entity, or create a false identity to mislead others, or which results in an unexpected, deceptive or unfair experience by others; and
- 5. **Be relevant**. Don't "spam" or solicit others without their consent, including duplicate postings, or multiple similar postings, or posting content that is not relevant to the discussion.
